'Big Hearts for Little Hearts' Records Holiday Children's Stories at Studio 1

LLBN recently sponsored the recording of six uplifting stories for young patients at Loma Linda University Children's Hospital during the Christmas season. It occurred at Studio 1 hosted by the 'Big Hearts for Little Hearts' Loma Linda Guild, a non-profit volunteer group. It encourages the public to view the Children's Hospital as the best place for Inland Empire youth to heal when they are sick or injured.

Each eight-to-ten minute episode, focused on positively handling life's challenges, was affectionately told by Mara Comadena, a kindergarten teacher in nearby Redlands, Calif. This year, a special emphasis was placed on dealing with isolation during the COVID-19 crisis.

The programs were overseen by Leigh Anderson, Director of The Children's Hospital Guild and guided by Kristi Franco, Chair of Christmas Events. Programs were regularly broadcast at all five Loma Linda University Health institutions through each patient's bedside TV. Last year, over 90-thousand views were logged during the Christmas period.


